Owners of income-producing properties have the opportunity to earn a state income tax credit for renovating historic buildings. The program offers property owners a tax credit up to 20% of eligible expenses, up to a total \$5 million, for substantial rehabilitation projects. Projects that achieve LEED Gold certification or equivalent, or are a certified low-income housing project may earn an additional 5% credit. Projects in a Qualified Opportunity Zone may earn an additional 5% credit (Level 1) or 7.5% credit (Level 2).

Eligibility

Buildings must be income-producing and certified as historic, defined as having at least one of the following designations:

- Individually listed in the National Register of Historic Places
- A contributing resource within a National Register Historic District
- A locally designated structure or contributing resource to a local historic district that MHT determines to be eligible for the National Register
- Located within and certified as contributing to the significance of a Certified Heritage Area
